Important information:

Please be informed that all applicants must schedule their student visa appointment using their own personal email ID and contact number. The Embassy of Italy strongly discourages the involvement of agents/agencies in the visa application process.

- All study certificates must be attested and apostilled for fresh admission. This is not required for an exchange programme.
- Ensure there are no discrepancies in the information provided across all the submitted documents. If there is a discrepancy in the applicant's name (or the sponsor's name) between the passport and any of the other documents, a "One and the Same" certificate, duly attested and apostilled, must be submitted.
- Kindly note that the processing time for a Study National Visa takes up to 90 days. We strongly recommend scheduling your travel accordingly. Please refrain from contacting the Embassy to request expedited processing, in detriment of those who applied earlier.

Study visa application for BACHELOR -Laurea Triennale - and MASTER'S DEGREES - Laurea Magistrale - enrollment for intake 2026/2027 **will not be accepted after 30th November 2026.**

Study visa application for BACHELOR -Laurea Triennale - and MASTER'S DEGREES - Laurea Magistrale - enrollment for intake 2027/2028 **will not be accepted after 31st October 2027.**

These deadlines are not applicable to all other courses (PhD, Specialization course/Master, Erasmus programmes, individual courses and foundational courses).

8	Accommodation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Adequate proof of boarding and lodging in Italy for at least 30 days: hotel booking OR Home Rent agreement OR Accommodation provided by University/Institute (with signed contracts). <p>For short term study visa, accommodation must be valid for entire period</p>
9	Language	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> B2-level English certification, if the course is taught in English (BRITISH INSTITUTES, CAMBRIDGE UNIVERSITY PRESS & ASSESSMENT, EDUCATIONAL TESTING SERVICE (ETS), PEARSON EDUCATION LIMITED, TRINITY COLLEGE LONDON) OR equivalent Medium of Education (MOI) declaration by the previous Higher Education Institution B2-level Italian certification, if the course is taught in Italian
10	Covering letter (recommended)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Statement of purpose (max 1 page) clarifying reasons for choice of course and Italian Higher Education Institution, means of financial supports, scholarship (if applicable) and intended accommodation.

¹ In case of minor students, it is mandatory to submit:

- Birth Certificate in original duly attested and apostilled (If there is only one legal guardian, the proof must be submitted e.g., Divorce certificate, Death certificate, Proof of sole custody duly attested and apostilled) + 1 copy
- If applicant is travelling with one of the parents: original APOSTILLED consent letter written and signed by the other parent.
- If the minor is travelling alone, both parents will be summoned to the Embassy to sign the consent letter.
- Guardianship acceptance letter of guardian in Italy + copy of ID + 1 copy

² The Pre-enrolment procedure applies to all non-EU applicants living outside Italy who need a study visa type-D to enter Italy for enrollment in an Italian Higher Education Institution recognized by the Italian Ministry of Education (MUR). It needs to be carried out through the UNIVERSITALY portal at the following link: <https://www.university.it>

³ Educational loan to be accepted as part of the financial means only if deposited and visible on bank statements submitted by the applicant. Else, the relevance shall be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.

⁴ If resident in India, those who can act as sponsor are: applicant's relatives until 4th degree kinship. Sponsorship can be provided with verifiable documents also by Italian or foreign nationals legally residing in Italy, institutions, Italian established authorities as universities and local Government bodies or foreign authorities recognized by Italian Government.
